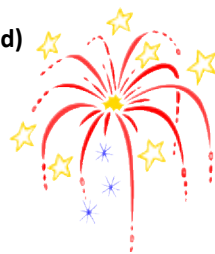

In 2013 she received High Distinction in 8th grade AMEB Viola, was accepted into and participated in the Australian Youth Orchestra's Young Symphonists program, and received runner up in the Ray Allen Scholarship. 2014 has seen her pass her AMEB Grade 7 musicianship exam, attend the Australian Youth Orchestra's national music camp and have her 2015 application accepted for this program. Emma is currently studying year 11/12 at Central Coast Grammar School whilst in her final term of the Diploma Course.

Mr Phillip Shovk (Adjudicator)



Phillip Shovk is considered one of Australia's foremost concert pianists, chamber musicians, accompanists and teachers. After studying at Sydney Conservatorium High School and graduating with the Frank Hutchens Prize, he continued his studies at the Moscow State Conservatory graduating as a Master of Fine Arts. Phillip has performed to great acclaim in Russia, Georgia, Portugal, France, Germany, Switzerland, Belgium, Singapore, New Zealand, China, Spain and the USA. He has also adjudicated many competitions such as the Sydney International Piano Competition, New Zealand National Concerto Competition, Sydney Eisteddfod, Yamaha Youth Competition, Hephzibah Menuhin Competition and many others. He currently Lectures in Piano and Accompaniment at Sydney Conservatorium of Music and has recently released a CD of Tchaikovsky and Mussorgsky on the Master Performer's label.
