WHAT IS THE SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP?

Central Coast Conservatorium (CCC) will offer a number of scholarships to students who are currently in the CCC Schools Program. The Scholarships deliver musicianship (or theory) classes along with one-to-one instrument lessons. This ensures that the instrumental component of music education is able to focus on performance and technique, while the musicianship class ensures the student's theoretical knowledge progresses in line with their abilities. We believe this combination of theoretical and practical teaching produces the best educational outcomes for our student musicians. Furthermore, we believe students should learn to perform and contribute as part of an ensemble. This helps develop discipline, leadership and cooperation and is also a fun way to come together with other music students, enter competitions and attend performances, and tour as a performing group. Our students are also encouraged to attend professional concerts which can be both inspiring and educational.

WHAT IS THE SCHOOLS SCHOLARSHIP?

Central Coast Conservatorium will offer 20 students from our Schools Program the opportunity to come on board in 2018 with a valuable scholarship that offers 50% off the cost of lessons, an ensemble and a musicianship class each term in the first year, 32% off in the second year and one free ensemble membership in the third year. These 20 students will be managed by a Schools Program Manager to ensure their successful progression from Year One into Year Two and Year Three. We will also ask parents and students for feedback on the program which will help us build a more successful program in 2019.

WHAT IS INCLUDED?

- Each scholarship is valued at \$2,971 over three years (based on current 2018 prices and estimated 2019/2020 prices. NB these values may alter slightly).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- Students must be enrolled in the Central Coast Conservatorium Schools Program to be eligible to audition for one of these spots.
- There are spots for Concert Band members as well as String Program students from Narara Public School, St Phillips String Program and Kincumber Public School.
- The Scholarship is open to students in late Primary School only (not High School and not Training Band). You can be graduating to High School in 2018.
- String students must have been learning for a minimum of two years.
- You must be a **new** one-to-one student at the Conservatorium (ie. you cannot already be getting lessons at the Conservatorium).
- You will receive an invoice each term and you must pay your portion within the terms of that invoice
- Scholarships may be withdrawn if attendance or commitment is deemed unsatisfactory
- Students must complete all four terms in 2018 and 2019
- Students must enrol in at least one ensemble per term plus a Musicianship class

ENSEMBLES ON OFFER:

- Primary Wind Ensemble – also known as Super Band
 - For students who are in Primary School in 2018
 - Rehearse on Wednesday evenings from 5pm to 7pm
 - Perform on the final Friday evening of Term in the Premier Ensembles Concert
 - Includes woodwind, brass, and percussion students
- Symphonic Wind Orchestra
 - For students who are in High School in 2018
 - Rehearse on Wednesday evenings from 5pm to 7pm
 - Perform on the final Friday evening of Term in the Premier Ensembles Concert
 - Includes woodwind, brass, and percussion students
- Saturday Morning Strings Program
 - String Students can join one of the graded ensembles depending on their level
 - Also includes a technique class
 - Ensembles rehearse on a Saturday Morning either 9am to 10am or 10am to 11am (depending on level)
 - Perform in String Fest each Semester
 - Invited to Crossroads Chamber Festival in September

MUSICIANSHIP:

- Most students will commence in Grade 1 Musicianship class
- Applicants will be assessed on their current level of knowledge and may enter at a higher grade
- Currently Grade 1 is offered on a Tuesday from 3.45pm
- Musicianship classes are one hour per week and each grade takes one year to complete
- Students can sit an in-house exam or do an online AMEB (Australian Music Examinations Board) exam at their own cost
- Our musicianship curriculum has been developed by Dr Phillip Rutherford and our students consistently achieve in their exams
