**LUNCH** will be provided on the day. Please bring a bottle of water and any snacks. Please let the office know of any special dietary requirements.

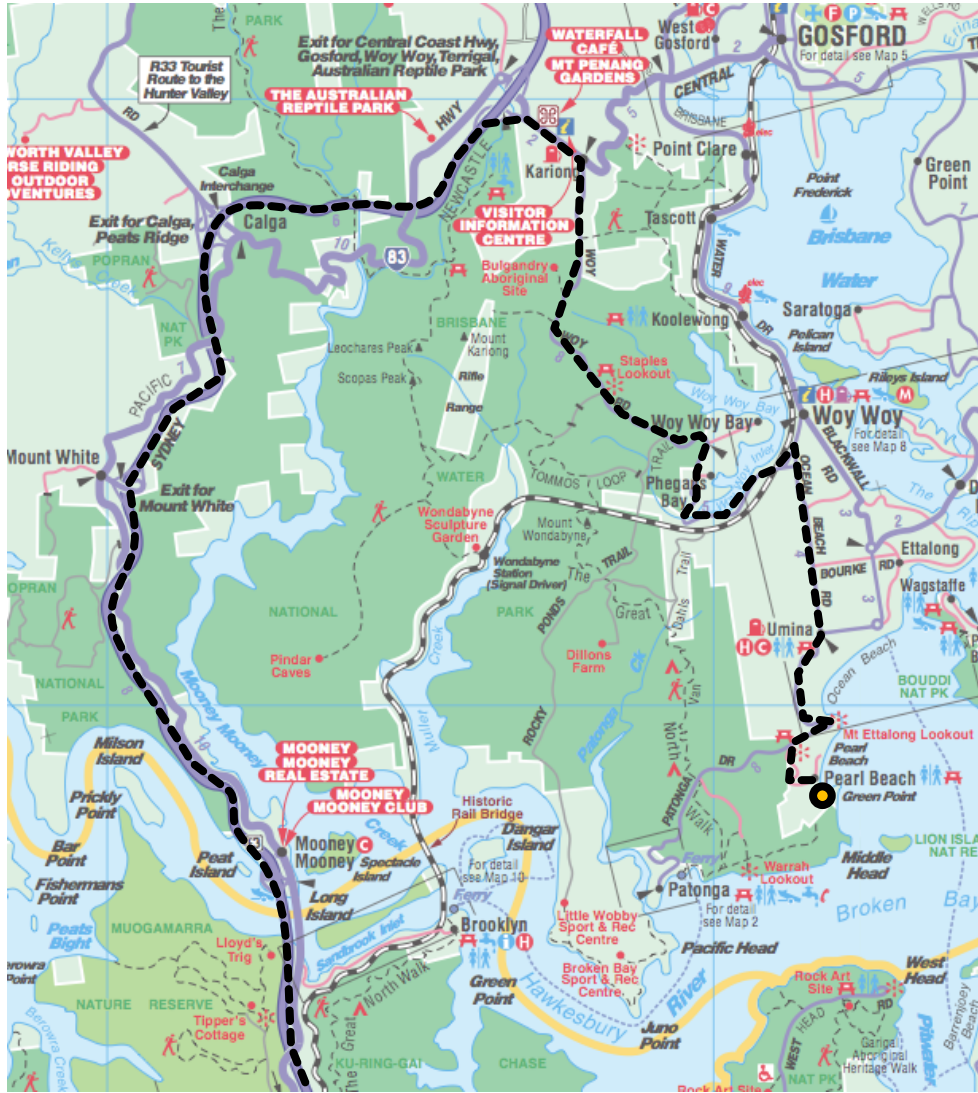
**CONCERT DRESS** is required for the performance: black shirt, black trousers or an appropriate length skirt. Formal shoes are required – sneakers are not permitted.
