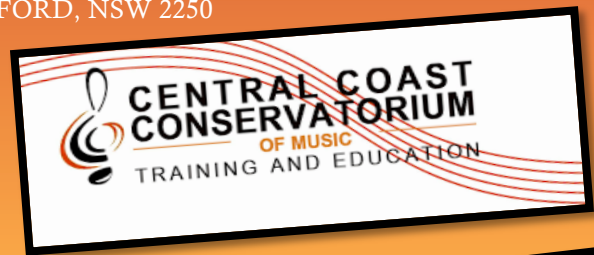
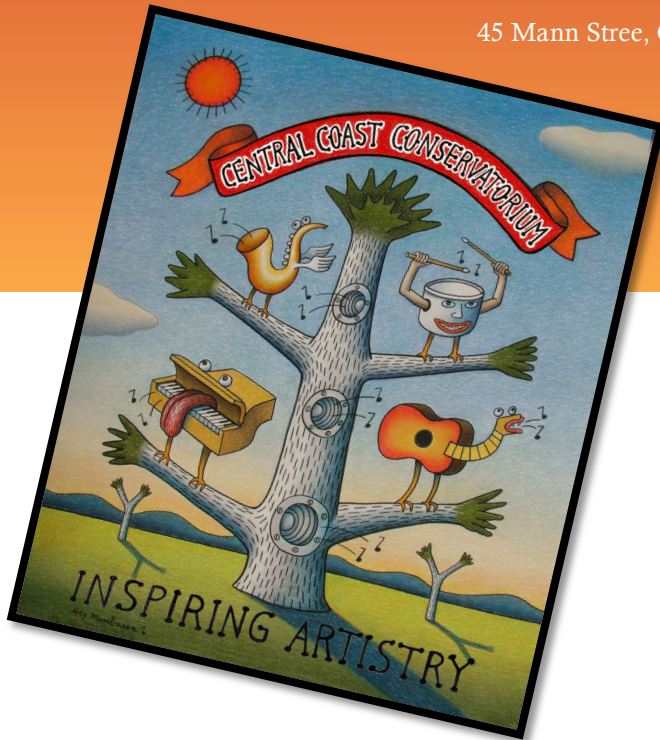

The Central Coast Conservatorium of Music is a not for profit, community based, non-tertiary institution,

It is funded by the local community in the form of tuition fees, sponsorship and assistance by the NSW State Government through grants made by the DET and Arts NSW.

At the CCCM music education commences at a young age to trigger a love of music. Our Children's Music Program takes a unique, graded and holistic approach to nurturing this love of music in our young children.



Our **In-Schools Program** has over 800 primary and high school students learning instruments in bands, plus violin, guitar and keyboard group lessons

**Private one on one lessons** with expert teachers who advance our students, instill in them a love of music and prepare them for outside exams (such as the AMEB), performances, Music in the HSC or a career as a musician or music teacher.



## The Central Coast Conservatorium...

- Is the third largest Conservatorium of Music in NSW and has Tier One status amongst regional conservatoriums, which it has maintained for the past six years.
- Delivers in excess of 35 000 equivalent teaching hours per annum.
- Employs 70 Music Teachers and administrative staff and has in excess of 400 one on one students
- Supports more than 20 ensembles from small Chamber groups to a full Youth Symphony orchestra.
- Runs Central Coast Opera Company and a major operatic production each year.
- Instructs in Music Theory
- Provides tuition in 25 schools on the Central Coast in the public, systemic and private spheres. This is generally in the provision of tutors and conductors in school band programmes.
- Partners with Symphony Central Coast, Central Coast Philharmonia Choir, Concertante Chamber Orchestra.
- Produces numerous concerts at the Conservatorium and at other Central Coast venues.
- Is the largest provider Music Therapy classes on the Central Coast.
- Provides a large number of scholarships to indigenous, disabled and able-bodied students on the Central Coast.
- Supports all forms of creative and performing arts including the provision of a Gallery for the display of student works of art.
