Terms and Conditions

About Central Coast Instrufest

Central Coast Conservatorium of Music is launching the inaugural Central Coast Instrufest - a five-day competitive music festival being held at Robert Knox Hall, Gosford, from Tuesday 8 - Saturday 12 October 2024.

The school holiday competition is being sponsored by Central Coast Council and will be held across five days with age-based categories in vocal, piano, strings, guitar, brass, percussion and woodwind. The contest will also be open to small ensembles of any instruments.

The performances will be judged by qualified adjudicators, with a selection of competitors being chosen to perform again in the Championship Showcase on 12 October. Prizes will be awarded at the Championship Showcase for most promising musicians.

Central Central Coast Instrufest is open to anyone aged five and over, with age categories and open sections.

General Entries

1. Entries must be completed at <https://events.humanitix.com/central-coast-instrufest>. In the event of the cancellation of Central Central Coast Instrufest your entry fee will be reimbursed.
2. Entries close 8 September 2024. Late entries will NOT be accepted, no extension of time or phone entries will be accepted.
3. This is a guide only and is subject to change.

4. Entry is \$10 per section. If you enter in more than one section, you will be required to pay \$10 for each individual entry.

General Rules for Central Coast Instrufest Competition

5. Eligibility:
 - a. Participants must adhere to the specified age or category requirements for each competition. Age categories and divisions will be specified for each competition.
6. Registration:
 - a. Participants must register online or through designated registration forms by the specified deadline.
 - b. Late entries will not be accepted.
7. Repertoire:
 - a. Participants must adhere to the specified repertoire guidelines for each competition.
 - b. Changes to repertoire must be approved by the competition committee in advance.
8. Performance Time:
 - a. Participants must adhere to the allotted performance time limits of 3 minutes.
 - b. Time penalties may apply for exceeding the allocated time limit.
9. Accompaniment:
 - a. Accompanists, if required, must be arranged by the participant at their own expense.
 - b. Central Coast Conservatorium may provide accompanists for a fee upon request.
10. Judging:
 - a. Competitions will be judged by qualified adjudicators appointed by Central Coast Instrufest.
 - b. Judges' decisions are final and not subject to appeal.
11. Conduct:
 - a. Participants and audience members are expected to maintain respectful conduct throughout the event.
 - b. Disruptive behaviour may result in disqualification or removal from the premises.
12. Recording and Media:

- a. Central Coast Instrufest reserves the right to record, photograph, or film performances for promotional purposes.
 - b. Participants may request copies of recordings upon completion of the competition.
13. Disqualification:
- a. Central Coast Instrufest reserves the right to disqualify participants who do not comply with the rules or fail to meet eligibility requirements.
14. Attendance: participants must be present and ready to perform at their scheduled times. Failure to attend may result in disqualification unless prior arrangements have been made with the organizers.

Rules of Entry for Central Coast Instrufest Competition

15. Entry Fees:
- a. A non-refundable entry fee must accompany each registration.
 - b. Fees vary based on competition category and are outlined in the competition guidelines.
16. Age Categories:
- a. Competitions will be divided into age categories (e.g., Under 10, Under 12, Under 15, Under 18, Over 18 and Open).
 - b. Age of participants is determined as of September 1st, 2024, of the competition year. Entrants in sections subject to age limitation must be prepared to submit proof of age if required.
17. Adjudication Criteria:
- a. Judging criteria will be based on technical skill, interpretation, stage presence, and overall performance quality.
18. Prizes and Awards:
- a. Prizes may include certificates, medals, scholarships, or other forms of recognition as determined by Central Coast Instrufest.
 - b. Prize distribution and awards ceremony details will be communicated to participants after judging.
19. Withdrawal Policy:
- a. Participants must notify Central Coast Instrufest in writing if they wish to withdraw from a competition.
 - b. Refunds for withdrawal may be granted under exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the organizers.

20. Special Requirements:
 - a. Participants requiring special accommodations (e.g., accessibility needs) must inform Central Coast Instrufest at the time of registration.
21. Code of Ethics:
 - a. Participants, teachers, and parents/guardians are expected to uphold a code of ethics promoting fairness, integrity, and respect for all competitors.
22. During Competition: The doors to the Robert Knox hall will be closed during an item. Please refrain from entering or exiting a performance venue during an item or moving around the hall during a performance.
23. Entrants should be present for the entire session in which they perform to provide both an appreciative audience for other entrants and for the learning experience of watching and listening to other performers.
24. Additional Rules:
 - a. Additional rules specific to each competition may be outlined in supplementary guidelines provided by Central Coast Instrufest.
 - b. Participants are responsible for familiarizing themselves with all competition rules and guidelines.
25. Instruments must be warmed up outside the hall prior to the commencement of your section.

Music

26. Music must be registered with the Music Secretaries prior to the commencement of the relevant session [not your section.] Entrants not registering music in the correct format and in good time, may forfeit any placing and may be eligible for adjudicator's comments only. Music Secretaries are in charge of the audio backing tracks.
27. All Music is Own Choice.
28. All competitors are entitled to perform in the Open Sections if the level of performance is at a high standard.
29. Entrants may enter more than once in an instrumental solo, if a different instrument is played.
30. Copyright: All entrants, accompanists and music teachers please note. The Australasian Mechanical Copyright Owners Society Ltd. [AMCOS] which is administered by Australasian Performing Rights Association Ltd [APRA] has issued strict regulations covering the use of music by performers and accompanists. It is the responsibility of the entrant and/or accompanist to be familiar with the copyright regulations and to present and use music in accordance with the regulations.

31. If a separate accompaniment score is published, the accompanist must use original music. If not published separately, the accompanist may use a photocopy of the original music. This must be clearly marked "Accompanist Copy" and may not be retained after the performance. It must be handed into the Music Secretary, for disposal.
32. Central Coast Instrufest will not be liable for any copyright infringements resulting from the entrant performing from copied music. Entrants should be aware of the rules of copyright and present and use music accordingly. The presentation of the music in the correct format is the responsibility of the entrant.
33. If an entrant is using CD/USB, please ensure that you have a back-up copy. It is advisable to supply your own player/device that your music is compatible with.
34. Time limits for all sections are 3 minutes
