The Soundwaves Ensemble Program aims to provide an enriching and enjoyable ensemble experience, helping students enhance their performance and collaboration skills while fostering new connections. Each day, participants will engage in:

Soundwaves Primary Wind Ensemble

For Year 4 to 6 students (students must be AMEB Grade 1 or equivalent or have at least one year of experience in their school band)

Soundwaves Junior Wind Ensemble

For Year 7+ students (students must be AME B Grade 2+ or equivalent or have played with their school band for 2+ years)
